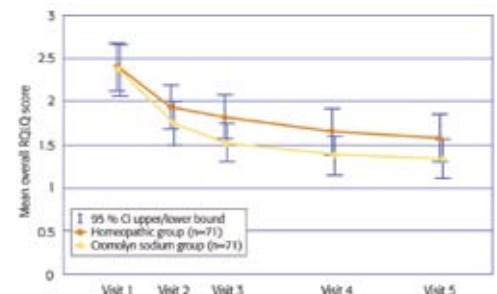

Clinical Research

In a randomized equivalency trial, 146 patients with symptoms of hay fever were treated either with Luffa compositum nasal spray (now sold as **Luffeel**) or cromolyn sodium nasal spray (sold in the U.S. as Nasalcrom®). Significant and clinically relevant decrease in symptoms was reported in both groups, with tolerability rated excellent. It was determined that treatment of seasonal rhinitis (hay fever) with Luffa compositum (**Luffeel**) is as safe and effective as conventional treatment with the allopathic solution of cromolyn sodium (Nasalcrom®).¹
